KS1 enjoyed their WOW day, getting ready for our new history unit on Toys from the Past. Children brought in their cuddly toys from home and we discussed why they are special to us. We made some toys in the afternoon. Children made a cup and ball game and enjoyed playing with them. We then finished the day with a teddy bear picnic, where we had some biscuits and juice.



We hope you are all doing well and have had a good start to the New Year. The children have settled down very well after their Christmas break and have lots to get stuck into in their Spring term. In LKS2 Art lessons this half term, the children are focussing on improving their painting techniques, using their knowledge to create tints and shades of different colours, and then using their tints and shades to create 3D pictures. In Science, we have finished our unit exploring the human body and how we keep ourselves healthy. So in our Science lessons this half-term, we will be learning all about the science of Sound. The children will be getting hands on with lots of experiments to help them visualise vibrations and waves.

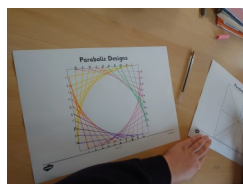
