In key stage one this week we have begun our learning about sculptures in our art lessons. We rolled paper around different cylindrical objects and snipped the bottom to then stick it securely on to a base. We thought about using different heights for our cylinders to add different 3D dimensions. It was lots of fun and the children produced some fantastic sculptures.



Last Thursday, children in Sealion, Dolphin and Orca class enjoyed a walk along our local river: the River Ivel. They sketched the human and physical features of the river on their own map such as the meander, tributary, floodplain, weir and bridges. Children also considered how the Ivel was used both now and in the past and why it is important for the local community. The river was once used to power the local mill and now it is used for leisure such as fishing as well as being an important habitat.

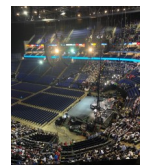
