Today, we had loads of fun as it was NUMBER DAY!

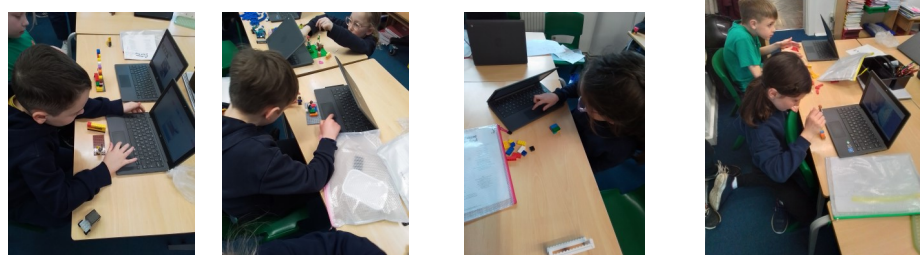
