KS1 have been busy this week creating their 'Tree of life' 3D creations, by practising their paper folding and folding skills that they have learnt throughout our art unit. I am sure you will agree they look fantastic!

As a whole school, we celebrated **Number Day**, our KS1/2 pupils took on the challenge of researching, planning, and organizing a **hypothetical class trip**, using their maths skills in a real-world context.

Key Activities:

- **Budgeting & Cost Calculations** – Pupils researched ticket prices, transport costs, and meal expenses.
- **Itinerary Planning** – They scheduled the day, factoring in travel time and activity durations.
- **Distance & Time Calculations** – Worked out journey times using maps and timetables.
- **Fundraising Ideas** – Planned ways to raise money to cover costs.

Presentation & Decision-Making – Groups pitched their trip ideas, justifying choices using maths.

This activity made maths practical and engaging, allowing pupils to develop problem-solving, teamwork, and real-life numeracy skills in a fun and meaningful way!
