



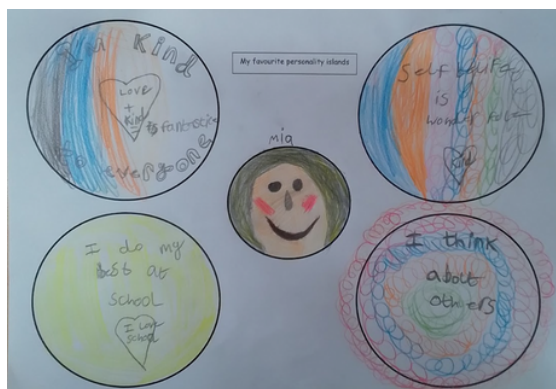
KS1 : We are excited to welcome the children back this week to hear all about the fun they had over half term. In Art we finished off our unit on paper play and made some artwork based on the Tree of Life. In English we have started our new unit based on the book 'That Rabbit Belongs to Emily Brown'. The children performed a role play pretending to be the Queen's servant asking for Emily's toy Rabbit in exchange for another toy of their choice. In Science we are starting our new unit 'Growing Things'. The children looked at different fruit and vegetables and discussed what they could see. They then sketched them and labelled what they could see.





KS2: In English, we are coming to the end of our unit on the Snow Queen, after which we will be looking at non-fiction recounts using the story 'Little Mouse's Big Book of Fears' by Emily Gravett. In maths, we will shortly be completing our units on Length and Perimeter and will turn our focus onto the study of Fractions.

In our upcoming Design and Technology lessons we will be designing, making and testing a slingshot car, and in Science, we will be investigating Rocks and Fossils, which is always a firm favourite with the children.
