It will be a busy one! The year 4s are looking forward to their residential at Grafham Water Centre. When the year 4s are away, the year 3s will take part in an art project and enjoy a trip to the park.

### Mathematics

Currently, the year 4 children are learning about decimals and their relationship to fractions. In June, they will have their times tables check so any help you give them in practising their tables is extremely valuable. Before the end of the year they will cover money, time, shape, statistics and position and direction!

Year 3 children are learning about Mass and Capacity, before moving on to further work on fractions, money, time, shape and statistics.

Both year groups learn arithmetic and times tables as part of a daily routine.

### English

Our new non-fiction English unit is based on chronological reports and looking at real stories including inspirational people.

In our poetry unit we will be looking at a wide range of poems and having a go at learning some poems by heart.

Our fiction book this summer term is Fantastic Mr Fox. The children will explore the text using drama and then have a go at writing their own narrative story including dialogue. They will be expected to edit their stories to make improvements and then have an opportunity to share feedback with their peers.

### Science and Foundation

#### Subjects:

In Science, we will be studying States of Matter focusing on solids, liquids and gases. Then we will be moving on to Living Things where we will look at classifying different living things.

#### History:

We will be studying the Mayan civilization and how the achievements of the ancient Mayas impacted their society and beyond.

#### Geography

In geography we will be trying to answer the question of why people live near volcanoes.
