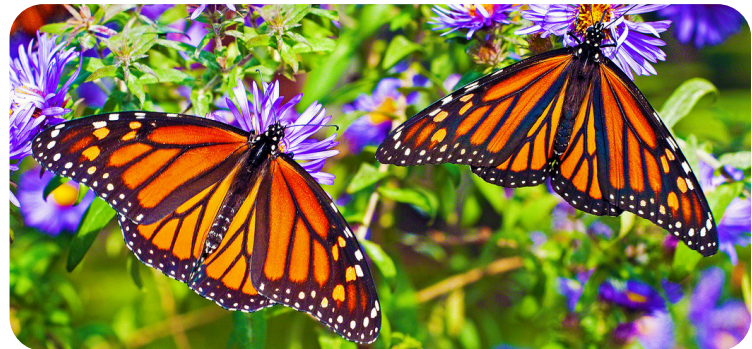
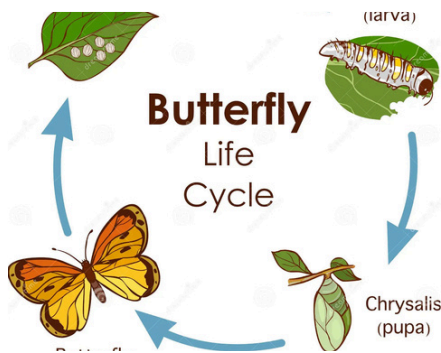




KS1 have enjoyed continuing the current Art unit - Colour Splash. We have been investigating mixing primary colours and looking at other artists work for inspiration.
