These small actions help create a school environment where everyone feels seen, heard, and valued.







KS1 has had another busy week. In English we have started writing our own version of the Three Little Pigs and designing our own characters to be used in the story. We have been working hard at forming full sentences and practiced putting together sentences that have been muddled up. Remembering to start with a capital letter and end with a full stop. In Science we have continued our unit all about animals. We have been learning about what animals need to survive and how to look after them.





In Science, our LKS2 pupils have been exploring the topic of electricity. We've been learning about the difference between battery power and mains electricity, and how each can be used safely. To put our learning into action, the children played with fun games and toys using battery-powered equipment. This hands-on activity helped them understand how electricity makes things work and why safety is important when using mains electricity at home or at school.


