At Langford Village Academy, we teach our children that every person has a story – and that it's important not to judge someone before we truly know them.

In a world full of differences, acceptance means welcoming others for who they are, even when they don't look, speak, or act the same as we do. It's about being open-minded, kind, and curious – not critical.

We encourage our students to:

- Pause before making assumptions about others.
- Ask questions and listen to understand someone's background or feelings.
- Celebrate differences, whether in culture, personality, or interests.
- Stand up for others who may feel left out or misunderstood.

When children learn to accept others without judgment, they help create a school where everyone feels safe, respected, and valued.

This week, why not ask your child: "Have you ever changed your mind about someone after getting to know them?" These conversations help build empathy and understanding – values we hold close at school.

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


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
