





This week in KS1, we've been busy building our math's skills by working on number bonds and using bar models and part-whole models to help us add with confidence. In English, we are finishing our unit on the book *On the Way Home* by Jill Murphy. The children have loved following Claire's imaginative journey and hearing all the reasons she gives for how she hurt her knee. They even created their own versions – we really enjoyed reading their creative and funny ideas! Well done to all the children for a fantastic start to the year. They have settled into their new classes and routines well and we are very proud of them. We hope you all have a fun and restful half term break.

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In LKS2 Maths, the children have been studying addition and subtraction, using their understanding of place value to help them add and subtract up to 3-digit numbers crossing ones, tens and hundreds. Following on from this the children will begin their new units on multiplication and division.

In English, the children have been enjoying learning to recite poems and creating their own poems based around ones they have read. Following the Autumn break we will move on to focus on information texts, looking at Produce of the Rainforest.

We will also be leaving our Stone Age, Bronze Age, Iron Age History unit behind, the children have really enjoyed their learning about prehistory and have produced some fantastic Prehistoric Art as well.

After the break we will move away from History and start a new Geography unit exploring human settlements and investigating what makes a good place for a settlement and whether they are all the same.
