We have had a great first week back after the half term in KS1. We have enjoyed starting our new English unit linked to the book, 'Paddington' and have made lost and found posters as well as writing a recount about Paddington's journey to London. In maths, year 1 have continued with their addition unit, trying hard to solve addition word problems and use their number facts to 10 to help them. We have also been solving missing number addition calculations. In year 2 we have been adding 2 digit numbers across a ten.

In geography we have started to use atlases to identify and label some of the UK's most famous landmarks and features and in science we have started our new unit on 'Seasonal Changes', with an observational walk around the school grounds to notice any signs of autumn. In DT, we have been exploring stable structures and balancing using beanbags.



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This half term, Year 3 and 4 will be developing their skills in indoor athletics. Pupils will be working on running, jumping, and throwing events: learning how to improve their speed, strength, and coordination. They've particularly enjoyed this week's focus on jumping demonstrating good technique, great enthusiasm and team spirit throughout. It's been brilliant to see everyone encouraging each other and celebrating personal bests. These sessions are not only helping to build fitness but also confidence, resilience, and cooperation – all key skills that go beyond sport. 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
