



They began by learning about part-whole models and using cubes and counters to build a strong understanding of number relationships. They have applied this knowledge to write 'fact families' calculations and to solve missing number problems with increasing confidence. The children then moved on to different strategies for subtraction, including crossing out and using number lines to support their calculation.







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Newsletter - 14.11.2025


