This week in year 5 we have started looking at division in maths. We have learnt about different methods to divide bigger numbers and found the most efficient way is using the "bus stop" method.

The children have worked with increasingly large numbers and are doing a super job! They have all realised how important it is to know their timetables to help them. To support them with this you could encourage them to play games online such as "hit the button" and "wall multiplication."

In Science we looked at the growth of babies and what the average growth would be through the first year of their lives. The children were very surprised to know how quickly a baby grows in height. We also identified what else is measured at birth and then at check-ups throughout the babies first year. The children used 'Purplemash' to plot the data and created different graphs to present this.









Key Stage 1 thoroughly enjoyed their WOW day introduction to our Amazing Africa Topic last week. They tasted the fruits listed in the African tale 'Handa's Surprise', found Africa on a world map and created a traditional African necklace. The children were brave and all tried new things. Penguin class then wore their necklaces and had a go at doing the jumping dance – a traditional dance of the Maasai tribe.
