

In year 5 we have been as busy as ever! In maths we have learnt about multiplying fractions which has been easier than it sounds! The children have learnt to do this on a number line, using bar models and mentally.

In our English lessons, we have continued our studies about The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe. The children have created their own settings and produced detailed paragraphs about these pictures. We have now moved onto letter writing; if you get a chance, show the children how different letters are laid out at home.

In Science, the children have investigated thermal conductors and insulators. They all set up experiments to test the best thermal insulator for a new lunch box!

As part of our topic we have learnt about how to read map co-ordinates and looking at OS map symbols.
