

Otter Class

Our topic this term is 'The Vikings'. We all enjoyed the visit of Hitchin Museum where the children were given the opportunity to wear Viking armour. They followed this up by making their own Viking Longships which they have done in great detail.

In Maths the children have been exploring the concept of Place Value, an important foundation for much of what they will be learning. They have looked at the values of digits, represented numbers in various ways and ordered and compared numbers in a range of different ways.



In English the children have been enjoying the African tale of Mufaro's Beautiful Daughters. We have described jungle scenes, used role play to explore the character's actions and written conversations between the two daughters
