UKS2 (Year 6) Newsletter -Summer 2023

Values: Happiness, Respect, Honesty and Thoughtfulness

The children have worked very hard this year, tackling the Yr 6 curriculum with enthusiasm and diligence. They have grown in confidence and broadened their knowledge and understanding in many areas.

In May (9th—12th) we will be completing our SATs, the first children to do so at Langford Village Academy. It is really important that children are present during this week, so please do not make any appointments or have any days out of school that week.

Whilst SATs are important they are only a part of the children's education and we will be exploring many new areas of learning and revisiting some old ones over the Summer term. The learning never stops!

Finally, I just want to say it has been a privilege working with the children and seeing how they have really grown and matured over their time at Langford.

Mathematics

This term the children will be discovering about:

Angles—on a straight ,line, around a point and within shapes: triangles and quadrilaterals.

They will also be looking at the parts of a circle: radius, diameter, circumference and arcs.

The children will be suing coordinates to plot points in all 4 quadrants, and how to translate and reflect shapes.

English

This term the children will be exploring a range of fiction texts: Street Child (Berlie Doherty), and writing on-fiction Blogs and Travel Reports.

Our reading work will focus on supporting out inferences by referring to the text, analysing figurative language and much more.

The children will develop their understanding of grammar and punctuation.—such as colons, semicolons and parenthesis.

Topic and Science

In History and Geography we will be investigating the local area: how it has changed over the years. The children will learn how to map their locality and explore how land is used in our area.

In Science we will be looking at Evolution: the science and the evidence for it and how animals and plants adapt to their environment.
