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The children in EYFS have been excited by our Coronation themed topic work this week. We have learnt about King Charles III and looked at photographs of him as he was growing up. We have investigated landmarks that can be seen in London and used our skills to build these with our construction toys. Our maths has focused on pattern and we have made repeating patterns on our crowns.

KS1 children have been enjoying PE on the field again, they are playing Kwik cricket and tennis this half term. We have been learning about paper illusions in art and Seahorse class tried to make their own thaumatropes and enjoyed testing them out. We are looking forward to having a fun day of celebrations for The King's Coronation and we will tell you all about it next week!



Manta Ray are learning about fractions and decimal equivalents. Children are doing exceptionally well and can easily convert a fraction into a decimal and vice versa! In History, we learnt that the Anglo-Saxons were made up of different tribes of people that came to live in England over 1600 years ago. In Science, we have started our topic on 'Living Things and Habitats' and we are

currently observing whether our geranium cuttings will generate new plants that are genetically identical to the parent plant! Have a look in the picture – do you think we will be able to create little plant clones?!

We took two mixed teams to Henlow cricket club today for a Kwik Cricket festival.

We saw lots of brilliant batting, bowling and fielding and both teams showed their values and teamwork and showed great sportsmanship towards the other schools. All of the children came back with a smile on their face and felt very proud of what they had achieved.
