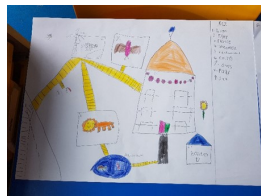

In Foundation Stage we have been exploring the story 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson. We have thought about how the snail is feeling at different parts of the story. We have learnt about some species of whales: orca, blue whale, beluga and the narwhal with its large horn. We have used pencil to draw a detailed picture of a shell that we explored really closely to find its pattern and texture. We were very lucky to have Will George lead our mindfulness activity on Wednesday afternoon as part of our well being week, so Mrs Beazley and Mrs Murphy got to join in this time as they usually lead the session on a Wednesday.

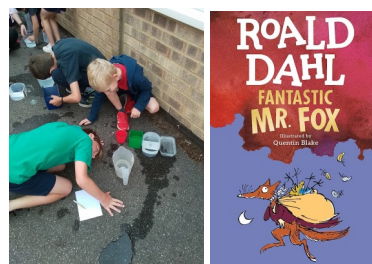
This week, in Key Stage 1, we have been busy with our Amazing Animals topic work. We have looked at different habitats and how the animals that live there have adapted to survive. We have also had great fun designing our own zoo park maps, using the Paradise Wildlife Park map as inspiration. We can't wait for our school trip to meet some of these animals close up!



The children in LKS2 couldn't wait to get started on their new English text this week; the fabulous 'Fantastic Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl. After reading the first three chapters of the book, the children have worked in small groups to come up with their own role play retelling the story so far. Each class has worked on their performance skills and working out which plot points are important to include in their role play.

The children have also been investigating the difference between capacity and volume in their maths unit on measurement. In this investigation they had a number of different sized containers, and were asked to predict the smallest and the largest capacity and to organise the containers in ascending order. Then they tested their theories by measuring how much water each of their containers would hold.
