We will start adding 2 groups of objects together to find the total as well as continuing to count accurately.

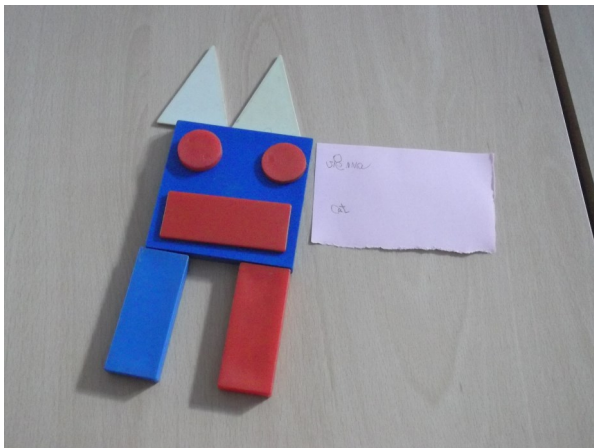
### English
