Lunchtime



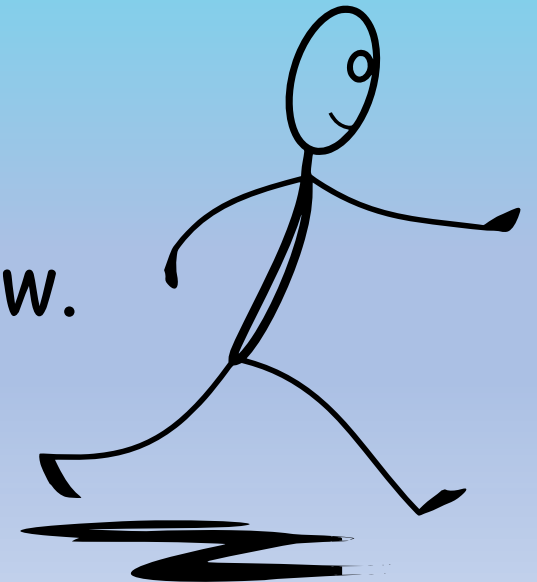

The children also need to know number bonds within 10, 20 and 100 and related facts:

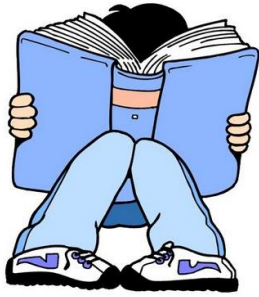
