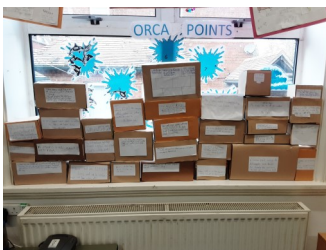

KS1 are really enjoying their new art unit. We have experimented creating secondary colours using primary coloured paint, a pipette, some water and a tray with paper in. The children were able to create some wonderful secondary colours, and learn a new technique at the same time. For our second art lesson we collected natural items displaying different textures from the playground. We then used tin foil, paint brushes, cotton buds, sponges and lolly sticks to create these textures ourselves. We also mixed our own secondary colours using the primary colours.

On Monday, LKS2 enjoyed a fantastic Roman Wow Day. In class, we had some impressively dressed Roman Gods, Gladiators and Emperors! The children really enjoyed designing and making their own Roman mosaics, soon realising it would have been a huge job creating mosaics for the floors and ceilings in Roman Villas. The children also learnt some facts about Hadrian's wall, and couldn't believe it was 6 metres tall and over 100km long! Each class had fun creating their own 'fact wall'.



In Year 5 & 6 Maths Club, we have been exploring numbers. We discussed what Square Numbers were and why they are called 'Square Numbers'. We then discussed if we could make other shapes out of multi-link and dienes. We discovered we could make Triangular Numbers. We worked out the first 5 Triangular Numbers and discussed what patterns we noticed. We then used this to help us create a rule for working out Triangular Numbers.
