Sea Lions had lots of fun making Hoop Gliders to show examples of comparative and fair testing. The children looked at what they could

measure and what they could change using their scientific skills.



This week has been Science week and all of the children have had the opportunity to visit the Planetarium. We will share some pictures next week.

Thank you so much for all of your donations for Comic Relief—so far you have helped raise £180! In Maths, KS1 have been learning about measurement. We have been practising measuring length, height and mass. As well as measuring in centimetres, we have used non-standard units of measurement to measure length. Seahorse Class were curious to know how many cubes would it take to measure Mr Gotham. Javi estimated that it would be 100. He was incredibly close- it was in fact 104!







Dolphin, Orca and Sea Lion classes have been learning about 'Caring for our Earth' in the RE unit this term. As part of their learning, they have thought about something practical they could do to care for our world. Dolphin class raised money to buy a tree which they planted in the school field last Friday. The tree is a Flamingo Tree (salixa integra) which has lovely pink leaves in the spring. Orca class decided to encourage people to save electricity. They thought about ways to do this and created a video presentation which they showed to all three classes. Sea Lion class designed posters to encourage us to turn off lights or pick up litter. Well done to our environmentally friendly children!
