




In Key Stage 1 this week, we have been super busy practising our Nativity play ready for the performances next week. The children are so excited to show you what they have been working on! Thank you to everyone for sending in costumes so promptly, the children will all look fantastic. Any last-minute costumes are needed urgently for Monday morning please. This week in English, we have started to look at The Nutcracker story, a magical tale set at Christmas time. We will be inventing our own version of the story next week.



We have been having a fun time in Manta Ray, completing our Greek scratch art vases and doing lots of science investigations! We have investigated air resistance by timing how long it took different-sized parachutes to fall to the ground, water resistance by timing how long it took different-shaped plasticine to sink and we saw the effects of gravity on objects that were different weights.

We were really chuffed with how our Greek vases turned out – they look fantastic! We coloured vases in with orange and red crayons, painted over them with black paint (mixed with a little washing up liquid) and then scratched our designs into them once they were dry. We've also had a new member join us in class – Ray the elf! He commandeered two of our parachutes and parachuted into class!
