



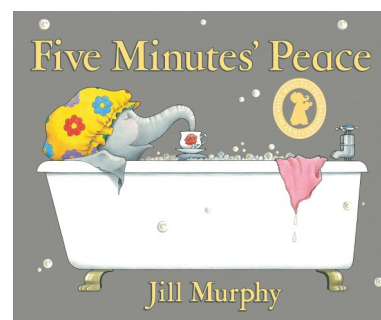

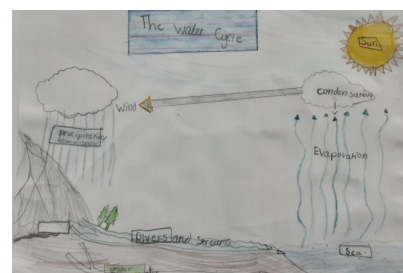
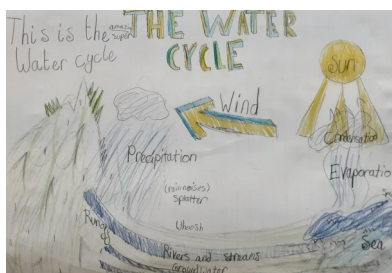
In science, we have been labelling the body and sharing existing knowledge of body parts. Lastly, in Topic you may have heard about a cheeky little mouse that lives in the corridors and learns alongside the children. He really enjoyed learning how things were different for the parents as children. Thank you for returning the questionnaires.

We have had a very busy week in LKS2 despite the short week. In topic we have continued our studies on rivers. This week, we have looked at 'The Water Cycle' understanding it's continuous process. The children produced some super labelled diagrams to help them understand the cycle.

In science, the children investigated which surfaces reflect light the best. They predicted which materials they thought would reflect the light the most, enjoying a practical experiment with the use of torches! Results were recorded and the overall conclusion was that shiny, smooth surfaces reflected best.
