This week KS1 have been developing their clay skills in their art lessons. – They have learnt the techniques of impressing and slip and score. They thoroughly enjoyed creating a tile, and all succeeded in using these new methods.



In LKS2, the children have had a fantastic time learning lots of interesting facts about ancient Egyptian life on their Egyptian WOW day. The children got hands on making a clay trinket dish and marking its base with their name or initials in Egyptian Hieroglyphs. They also had the opportunity to taste and review a selection of foods that the Ancient Egyptians would have eaten. Finally the children used their knowledge of geometry and shape to build a class pyramid by making cubes. They are now very much looking forward to starting their new History unit on Ancient Egyptians. The children brought in some amazing artefacts, books and builds for our Egyptian displays, and we had some amazing costumes as well.

In Maths, our Year 3 children are discovering more about fractions and our Year 4 children are looking at decimals, following which we will be starting our Money units.
