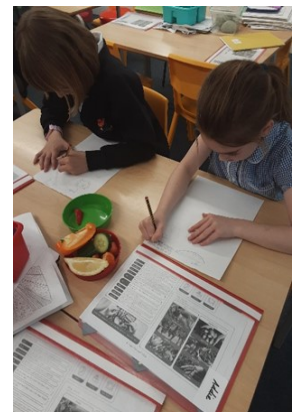

This week in Key Stage one, we have started a new Design and Technology project all about making a smoothie! WE have begun to identify fruits and will then move on to tasting and planning a delicious smoothie. Here are Penguin class, identifying and sketching a selection of fruits, paying particular attention to finding the seeds.



**LKS2 are starting this half term with two new units in maths and English. In our maths lessons we have started our 'Time' unit, beginning with learning Roman numerals and telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes in Year 3, and understanding different units of time, followed by converting between analogue and digital times in Year 4.**



**In English, we have started reading 'The Lion and the Unicorn', by Shirley Hughes, a story set in World War II, following the life of an evacuee. In our first lesson, the children have been designing their own coat of arms like referenced in the text. In their designs, the children have had to consider the special characteristics required in war time, such as trust, respect, courage and bravery, alongside the animals that embody these qualities.**
