This week, Key Stage 1 have been busy practising their counting skills and place value knowledge using all sorts of different apparatus.



We have also been learning all about the human body, drawing and naming parts of the body and thinking about how much we have grown and changed since we were babies. Thank you so much to everyone who sent in photos for our who's who displays.

Pupils in Sealion, Dolphin and Orca class welcomed Will George to talk about making choices and the range of decisions we make throughout our day. We practiced breathing techniques including how many deep “out breaths” we take within a minute. Children in Dolphin class remarked that this technique made them feel calmer, more relaxed and noticed they were feeling more focused. Will taught us about parts of the brain and how mindful practice helps us to train out prefrontal cortex. We will continue to practise throughout the week before Will’s next visit.
