LKS2 are enjoying their new Science unit 'Light & Shadow'. The children have been focusing on where light comes from and what are sources of light and what are not. This led to some interesting class discussions, including whether the Moon was a source of light or not – the children discovered it was not as it does not make its own light.



We can see the moon because light from the sun reflects off it back to the earth. The children then designed their own postcards to demonstrate how light travels in waves from a light source, bounces off the object and hits our eyes allowing us to see things.
