We have been working hard in KS1 this week. We discussed why we have fireworks on the 5th November and then made some artwork to show fireworks in the night sky. We have started our Geography unit for this half term looking at our local area. We used Google Earth to look at Langford and find some places that we all know. We found the church, the school and the playing field.



Children in Year 4 have been learning about area in Maths. They have been working systematically to investigate the area of rectilinear shapes and making shapes before drawing them.

Children have considered how learning about area can apply to real life problems such as laying patios or carpet tiles.
